Profile of the Community

UNEMPLOYMENT

 44% of the community is not working compared to an annual average of 7% in Kern County as a whole

EDUCATION

32% of residents do NOT have a high school diploma

Profile of the Community

POVERTY

45% of residents receive public assistance.
 1/3 of households have an income of less than \$12,000 a year

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

80% of all calls for Emergency Services in the area are drug-related

As a Result...



 64% of children in one district and 42% in another district are not ready for Kindergarten

 The rate of child abuse in the area is 70 reports per 1000 residents, seven times the rate for the state

Current Situation



- Children are unprepared for Kindergarten
- Income-eligible children are less likely to get into a state preschool
- Early Childhood Teachers lack training to identify social and emotional issues



Our Game Plan

- Increase Kindergarten readiness
- Increase number of children who attend preschool
- Improve ability of providers to identify social and emotional health indicators
- Increase numbers of children who receive early assessment/intervention

The Obstacles We Face

- Poverty
- Resistance to authority
- Outsiders taking advantages of opportunities
- Childcare providers who babysit and do not provide instruction
- Many SS/HS programs have trouble meeting Element V targets
