

- Gather input from many
- What do we want to know?
- Conduct surveys
- Conduct focus groups
- Use TAS and Communication TAS to get feedback
- Share information with all parties
- Ask "What else do we want to know?"



Be a Team Member

 To build a good working relationship the evaluator and project director need to be on the same team but play different roles



Role of the Evaluator

- Support the PD; help guide you in decision-making
- Understand the PD's job description
- Be an effective communicator
- Be available
- Collect both qualitative and quantitative data
- Tell the story

Role of the Project Director ANAHEIM

- Be clear about expectations with evaluator
- Have frequent communication with evaluator
- Include evaluator on calls with TAS



Role of the Project Director GEORGIA

- Be clear about expectations with evaluator
- Communicate often with your evaluator
- Include your evaluator on the agenda for Core Management Team meetings
- Work with your evaluator to create marketing materials that include data


