


Policies & Agreements: Suburban Ramsey County MN


- "Policy Action regarding Fundraising"
 - partners depend on collaborative to seek funding (eases their "fundraising burden")
 - focus on outcome---not program---funding
 - agree to seek \$\$\$ for administrative costs of the collaborative
 - agree to not "infringe on a partner's ability to get a grant that they have higher likelihood of receiving"



Policies & Agreements: NW MN Council of Collaboratives


Principles for Cooperation

- All Collaborative members are informed of all grant opportunities via email
- Partners must be current with paid dues in order to participate in grant opportunities
- Governing Board will hire, negotiate and establish Project Developer
- Project Developer must sign a "conflict of interest" agreement and not directly compete with the collaborative grant opportunity



Policies & Agreements: WA state

- Washington's ESD Prevention Centers
 - 9 ESDs in state promote student success by providing leadership, support, and resources to create a safe and supportive schools
 - Strong network of ESD Prevention Center
 Directors keeps everyone informed about funding opportunities; fosters collaborative efforts
 - Have no-compete understanding; worked with state OSPI office to change history of competition
