# Context

- 7% of:
  - \$9M = \$630,000
    - \$157,500/yr
  - \$6M = \$420,000
    - \$105,000/yr
  - \$3M = \$210,000
    - \$52,500/yr

# Basics

- What is the purpose of Evaluation?
  - *Evaluation should not simply be conducted to prove that a project worked, but also to improve the way it works.*

# Types of Evaluation

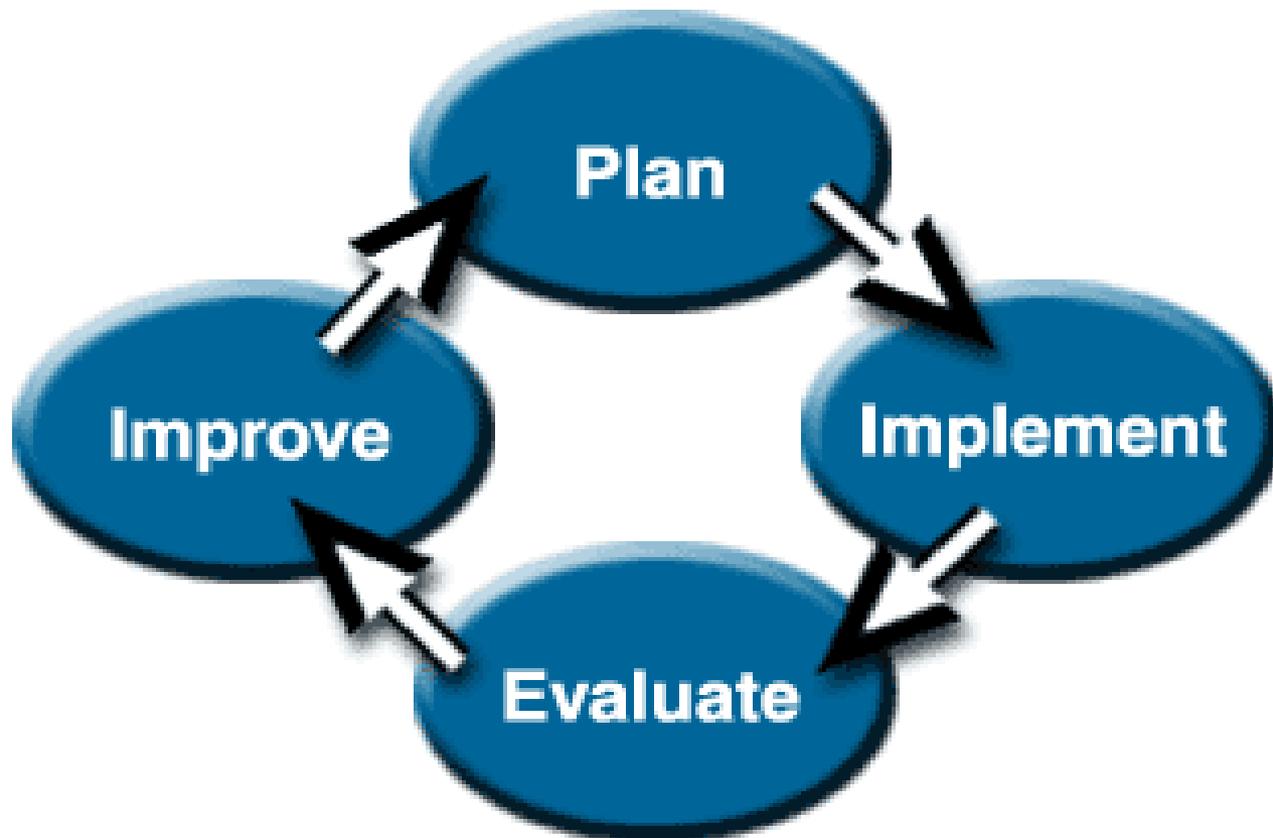
## Formative

- Process Evaluation
  - Was the program implemented as intended?

## Summative

- Outcome Evaluation
  - Were the project objectives achieved?

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- Theory of change

# Evaluation Questions

- How will you know if you have accomplished your goals?
- What are your expected outcomes?
- What activities will your project undertake to accomplish your goals?
- What information will your partners need about your shared outcomes?
- What environmental factors might help or hinder your ability to accomplish your goals?

# Process Measures

## Process Measures

## Indicators and GPRA

- How or Why?
- How or Why Not?

- Did I reach my objective?

# Process Measures

## Usual Suspects

- Number of Parent trainings
- Number of staff/teachers trained

## Particularly Useful

- Fidelity measures
  - Evidence-based Interventions
  - Theory-based interventions
- Local “calibrations” to EBIs
- Attempts to standardize non-EBI processes.

# Evaluation Plans

- Process Measures
- Outcomes Measures
- Data Collection Plan
- Data Analysis Plan
- Data Collection Instruments
  - Existing sources
  - Adjust/refine existing
  - Develop new measures

# Human Subjects

- Institutional Review Boards
  - Funded agency responsible
  - Review package contents:
    - Project/evaluation
    - Target population
    - Data collection tools/procedures
    - Informed consent/right of refusal
  - Yearly
  - Different levels of review

# Confidentiality

- Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)
- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)
- Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA)

# Evaluation Plans & GPRA

- GPRA:
  - 6 Indicators
- Local Evaluation:
  - Outcome measures
  - Process measures
- 10%
- 90%

# Reporting and Using Results

- What do you, other staff, and key stakeholders need to know more about?
- What decisions do you feel you need to make but need more information to make?
- What will you do with the answers to your questions?
- Who will make the decisions and when?
- How are decisions made in this organization?
- What other factors may affect the decision-making process?

# Qualifications

- Formal training
- Previous evaluation experience
- Professional orientation
- Previous performance
- Personal styles and characteristics

# Budgeting for Evaluation

- Evaluation Staff Salary and Benefits
- Consultants
- Travel
- Communications
- Printing and Duplication
- Printed Materials
- Supplies and Equipment
- Other

# Words of Wisdom

- Data ownership
- Yearly contracts
- Procurement issues
- Detailed invoicing
- Modification and Termination clauses
- Budget issues
