- Who, what, when, where, how?
 - Who is the best person to develop SMH program? Who provides what service?
 - What is the referral process? Who can refer?
 What are the confidentiality rules/laws?
 - When will the SMH program begin?
 - Where will the SMH program be located in the school to promote confidentiality?
 - How will the program be introduced to school staff, parents, youth, community?

- Education/Training of MH issues
 - Teacher/staff meetings
 - PTO meetings
 - Community organizations
- Introduce SMH program to school / community
 - Newsletters, flyers, classroom presentations, school website
- MH Stigma
 - What is the best way to address stigma ...
 - school, community
 - parents and youth





- School Governance
 - Determine roles & responsibilities for SMH staff
 - Who does SMH counselor report to at school?
 - Who will be the liaison for school and MH provider?
 - Work hours, holidays, family home visits, etc.
 - Supervisor of SMH program staff
 - Liability issues: school, community MH provider
 - Continually build relationships with school staff, school assistance team and community providers

- Work smarter, not harder!
 - Maximize resources
 - School assistance teams refer to providers
 - School teams provide interventions/services
 - Efficient use of time
 - Create manageable caseload for each SMH staff
 - Schedule time for intervention, consultation w/parents & teachers, planning/paperwork
 - Organization & time management = productivity, decreased stress and effectiveness


