



Phase I: Planning

- Community
 - Assess strengths, resources, needs & barriers
- Organizational support
 - School, community, agencies, organizations, parents
- Fiscal
 - Current school resources & community partnerships
- Questions
 - Who, what, when, where, how?
 - What is the level of support?
 - What does the funding require?

Phase I: Planning

- Strategy development
 - Which schools have the highest MH need?
