Lafayette County Exercise/Workshop Objectives:

- 1. Implement and evaluate the Emergency Operations Plans (EOPs) for the Lafayette County Sheriff's Office, School District/High School, and other county and city departments.
- 2. Coordinate efforts of Lafayette County emergency responders in an integrated response to a domestic terror school-based "active shooter" incident.
- 3. Evaluate the ability of the Lafayette County Sheriff's Office and other County departments/agencies to provide integrated response and support services during an emergency event.
- 4. Evaluate the implementation and use and pre-planning for the Incident Command System (ICS)
 - a). IC/UC is established
 - b). Transfer of Command is accomplished and communicated to all first responders and support personnel as warranted by the event
 - c). Incident Action Plan (IAP) is developed, of appropriate, and communicated to all responders and support (verbal or Written)
 - d). Operational Objectives in the Plan are communicated to appropriate responders supporting the event
 - e). Operational periods are established and relief resources are identified, as needed
 - f). Integrated Communications Plan is developed (if necessary)
 - g). ICS Command Staff and General Staff positions are designated and authority for key functions is delegated to the appropriate position
 - h). ICS facilities are designated, as appropriate
- 5. Evaluate the effectiveness of the Lafayette County emergency notification system, communications system and public information system.
- 6. Evaluate the Lafayette County Emergency Management Operations Center's coordination and resource support capabilities.

Lafayette County Sheriff's Office Objectives:

Communications Center:

- 1. Receive emergency calls and dispatch appropriate responders.
 - a) Establish facts from caller(s) or witnesses
 - b) Maintain "open line" with reporting caller(s)
 - c) Relay facts "real time" to responding units as new information is received
 - d) Notification of Supervisory Personnel and other emergency support services
 - e) Dispatch emergency call to appropriate responders with relevant facts and advisories
 - f) Establish communications priorities (frequency, coordinate requests for resources, relay messages, etc.)
 - g) Maintain and facilitate communications throughout the event
 - h) Maintains appropriate log of critical information for tactical and after-action review (manual or electronic playback system)
 - i) Notify the State Warning Point (SWP)
- 2. Facilitate the activation of the department's Emergency Communications Plan using the Department's emergency communication procedures. (Mobile CP)
- 3. Implement communication methods and procedures linking county and regional public health, hospitals and emergency management authorities.
- 4. Provide effective risk communication during this emergency in coordination with other local and regional players through the operation of a JIC.
- 5. Supports and facilitates ICS as determined appropriate for the event

Lafayette School District Office Objectives:

- 1. Evaluate school safety plan
- 2. Evaluate school site vulnerabilities (Access/entry points, visitor sign-in)
- 3. Evaluate emergency procedures

Uniform Patrol:

- 1. Emergency response procedures are followed
- 2. On-scene threat assessment is accomplished and communicated to appropriate personnel/authority
- 3. Scene security is established, communicated and maintained by available personnel
 - a. Curious on-lookers, concerned parents and the media are effectively contained and addressed
 - b. All visible persons at the scene are assessed, identified, identified and secured, as appropriate
- 4. Appropriate response tactics are employed by responding units
- 5. Area concerns are noted and appropriate protective measures are implemented to safeguard citizens and first responders
- 6. Traffic Control measures are recommended and implemented
- 7. Incident/Unified Command is established for on-scene operations
- 8. Resources are requested and deployed to meet the needs of the incident
- 9. Emergency medical attention is rendered, as appropriate
- 10. Identification and apprehension of suspects

Emergency Operations Center (EOC):

1. Notify the State Warning Point (SWP) and the RDSTF

- 2. Activate the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) or Mobile Command Post
- 3. Demonstrate security and coordination
- 4. Test communications systems.
- 5. Test resource requests and mobilization procedures
- 6. Provide effective risk communication during this emergency, by coordinating with other local and regional players through a Joint Information Center (JIC)
- 7. Draft and disseminate exercise messages that can be transmitted via landline, cell phone, radio, satellite phones, email, fax, etc.
- 8. Notification of area medical facilities for incoming patient care
- 9. Notify agencies/departments who may be called upon to provide support for the incident via Mutual Aid

Public Information:

- 1. Provides crisis and risk communications messages at onset of the incident
- 2. Established a Joint Information Center (JIC) or makes conscious decision that a JIC is not needed to support the event
- 3. Establishes a plan to handle anticipated calls from the media, public and parents of students at the school.
- 4. Establishes a plan to control media access while providing appropriate information through planned press releases, press interview or press statements

Lafayette High School/School Board Objectives:

- Coordinate activities with the DCSO School Resource Officer (SRO) and other responding SO units and other departments.
- 2. Notification procedures for the District School Board

- 3. Test emergency procedures for student safety and isolating students/employees from potential danger. (e.g. Evacuate, shelter-in-place, facility lock-down, etc.)
- 4. Evaluate procedures for the rapid identification and "accounting" of students, teachers and staff on campus.
- 5. Provide effective crisis and risk communication during this emergency in coordination with other local and regional participants through the operation of a JIC.
- 6. Implement notification procedures for parents and teachers. (Instructions for parents, meeting area, pick-up area, etc).
- 7. Evaluate campus access control and the identification card system.

Lafayette County Volunteer Fire Department Objectives:

Overall Objectives

- 1. Participate in Unified Command, if established
- 2. Evaluate all first response activities to respond to and support a domestic terrorist event
- 3. Establish incident objectives for the fire component and integrate objectives with other first response units
 - a) Fire support contingency plans based on incident
 - b) Request additional resources or capabilities through IC and/or EOC
 - c) Establish decontamination area, if warranted
- 4. Exercise Emergency Response Plan(s)
- 5. Provide direct support as required by the Incident Commander
- 6. Identify and perform non-traditional roles, if needed

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Objectives:

- 1. Determine the period of time that it takes to respond to the scene to provide victim treatment
- 2. Communicate information regarding patient count and condition to impacted trauma center
- 3. Treat patients at the scene
- 4. Establish triage area, if warranted
- 5. Coordinate the possibility of transporting a large number of potential victims if the hostage operation cannot be neutralized by law enforcement
- 6. Maintain communications with dispatch and hospital
- 7. Cooperate with the JIC by providing information, as necessary
