What we've learned...

- General template
- Keep it short
- Avoid lengthy document edited by all entities
- Use Statement of Practices
 - How we deal with data
 - How we are FERPA/HIPPA compliant

AISD Data Sharing Policy FL Regulation

- Category 1—Campus-wide access to student data
- Category 2—Access limited to particular views
- Category 3—No direct access, reports provided



AISD Aggregate Report Portal

- Service providers enter student IDs
- AISD generates aggregate report
 - Test scores
 - Discipline
 - Attendance
- Longitudinal
- Control groups
