


System Integration & Planning

- Step 1: Conduct a resource mapping process
- Step 2: Acquire copies of partner strategic plans
- Step 3: Conduct an analysis of each partner's activities
- Step 4: Identify areas that integrate with this initiative
- Step 5: System partner role in communicating this integration back into your system

Step 1: Conduct a Resource Mapping Process

Resource Mapping: a methodology used to link community resources with an agreed upon vision, organizational goals, strategies, or expected outcomes.

- 1. Mapping strategies focus on what is already present in the community; build on the strengths within a community.
- Mapping is relationship-driven. Key to mapping efforts is the development of partnerships--a group of equals with a common interest working together over a sustained period of time to accomplish common goals.
- Mapping embraces the notion that to realize vision and meet goals, a community may have to work across programmatic and geographic boundaries.


