Top Fundraising Mistakes of SSHS Grantees

ACCESSING OTHER GOVERNMENT FUNDING POOLS: Solution: WIA, TANF, AmeriCorps, Work Study funds are worth exploring.

MISREAD BUREACRACY: Solution: Whether its under or overestimating, internal leaders need to be sold to as well.





Top Fundraising Mistakes of SSHS Grantees

**STAY IN SEATS -** *Solution*: Get out of grant writing roles and start forming relationships that will spurn funding.

LACK OF SALESMANSHIP: Solution: Package materials, get clear on message, understand the power of measurable results, know place in future of community.

#### **UNDERUSE PARTNERSHIP/COLLABORATION:**

Solution: Rather than just share information, should share line items, people, legal status
