

The evaluation of SS/HS communities across the country found that as the result of their local initiatives:

- Fewer students reported witnessing and experiencing violence
- Teachers and students reported feeling safer in school.
- School staff saw improvments in their school's safety.
- More than 90 percent of school staff said they saw fewer violent incidents at school.
- Nearly 80 percent of school staff said their communities were less violent and that fewer students were using drugs and alcohol.
