### The case for integration...


- Understand each other's systems

- Step 3: Conduct an analysis of each partner's activities
- Step 4: Identify areas that integrate with this initiative
- Step 5: Use the information gathered in Steps 1-5


#### Prevention Model: A Framework for Resource Mapping



### Waterford School District Waterford, Michigan



- The Waterford School District is located within Oakland County in southeastern Michigan, 30 miles outside of Detroit 34 lakes in the Township Over 73,000 residents, ranging homeless through upper-class
- Thrived from the automotive industry
  - Recent influx of layoffs and home foreclosures due to economic hardships
- Over 11,700 students enrolled in grades preK-12
  - 1 Early Childhood Center, 12 Elementary Schools, 2 Middle Schools, 2 High Schools, 1 Alternative High School
  - Continued increase in homeless students
  - 48% Free/Reduced lunches
  - Growing Hispanic and African-American populations
- Strong support from community members and partners
